Major General Alfredo RAMIREZ

Alfredo Ramirez was born in Melilla (Spain) on 23 December 1954. He joined the Army as a cadet in the Military Academy in Zaragoza.

He completed his studies in the Signal Corps Academy, being promoted to the rank of Lieutenant in 1975.

As a Lieutenant he was appointed for different posts in the paratrooper Brigade.

As a Captain, he was teacher at the Signal Corps School and as a helicopter pilot in the Transport Battalion (CH47)

As a Lieutenant Colonel he was appointed to the Eurocorps Staff in Strasbourg (France) and also as COS of the Army Aviation Bde (FAMET).

As a Colonel he commanded the 1st Signal Regiment in Burgos and served as COS of CIS Army Staff Directorate.

As a Brigadier General he became the Deputy Chief of Staff Support of HQ Eurocorps.

As a Major General he became the Chief of Staff of HQ Eurocorps

He is Knight of the French Legion of Honor and Commander of the Belgian Order of the Crown.
